FOLLOWING VOTING LAWS PROTECTS YOU AND YOUR PATIENTS

There have been instances of facility staff being convicted and jailed for forging signatures on absentee ballot request forms and filling out ballots for patients with dementia.

It's important you follow federal and state voting laws. Answering the questions below can help you learn how well you know the voting laws in your area:

- Can I get in trouble for assisting a resident completing a ballot?
- Has someone asked me to suggest a candidate to my residents? Because that's not ok.
- Does the law allow me to collect or submit ballots for multiple people?
- What do I do if asked to assist with a ballot for someone who doesn't know their name or the names of the candidates running?
- Am I making sure ballots are stored securely?
- Am I being careful not to tell residents which candidates to vote for?
