IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW WHEN ASSISTING YOUR LOVED ONE WITH VOTING:



A loved one who cannot express their wish to vote in the election should not have a mail-in-ballot or an absentee ballot application filled out for them.



A loved one who cannot EITHER express their wish to vote in the election, or cannot indicate their preferred choice on the ballot should not have a ballot marked for them.

All state laws are different and change frequently. Family members should seek their organization's legal counsel with detailed questions.
